- Proprietary Competition Content.** The CompSciComp problem sets, scoring rubrics, grading data files, and season structure are original content created exclusively by Mayflower Computer Science. This content is not licensed to or reproduced by any other vendor.
- Unique Technical Platform.** CompSciComp’s combination of automated Java source code grading, cloud-based execution infrastructure, and real-time score broadcasting is a proprietary system not replicated by any comparable educational competition product.
- Continuity of Established Program.** The requesting institution has previously participated in CompSciComp competitions. Switching vendors would result in loss of historical performance data, student familiarity with the platform, and continuity of the established competition season structure.
